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## ESIC UDC Syllabus

The Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) conducts the UDC (Upper Division Clerk) recruitment through three stages: Prelims, Mains, and Computer Skill Test. Candidates must qualify in each stage to proceed further. The Preliminary exam and Computer Skill Test are qualifying, while the final selection is based on marks obtained in the Mains examination.

**Selection Process:**

Phase I – Preliminary Examination

Phase II – Main Examination

Phase III – Computer Skill Test

**Preliminary Examination:**

The Prelims is an online objective test with 100 questions for 200 marks and a duration of 60 minutes. It includes Reasoning, General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude, and English Comprehension. Each correct answer carries 2 marks, and 0.25 marks are deducted for wrong answers. This stage is qualifying only.

**Main Examination:**

The Mains exam consists of 200 objective questions for 200 marks with a duration of 2 hours. It covers Reasoning, General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude, and English Language with a higher difficulty level. Each correct answer carries 1 mark, and 0.25 marks are deducted for incorrect answers. The final merit list is prepared based on Mains marks.

**Computer Skill Test:**

Candidates who qualify in the Mains appear for a Computer Skill Test involving PowerPoint presentation, MS Word typing and formatting, and MS Excel table preparation using formulas. The test is 30 minutes for 50 marks, but the marks are not included in the final merit list.

**Syllabus Overview:**

The syllabus includes Reasoning and General Intelligence, General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude, and English Language. Important topics include puzzles, coding-decoding, number series, banking and economic awareness, percentages, ratio and proportion, profit and loss, time and work, averages, grammar, vocabulary, sentence correction, and reading comprehension.

**Qualifying Marks:**

Candidates must obtain minimum qualifying marks in both Prelims and Mains: 45% for UR, 40% for OBC, 35% for SC/ST/ESM, and 30% for PwD candidates.

Overall, success in the ESIC UDC exam requires strong preparation in reasoning, quantitative aptitude, English language, general awareness, and basic computer skills.
